Homework

The children will have the following work to bring home:- A Home Reading Book, Phonics Work and Key Words. They are all doing brilliantly with their reading but we are keen to focus on phonics with the phonics screening check in mind. Worksheets are put into phonics books for both Year 1 and Reception on Fridays. Other homework will be given as, and when appropriate. The children will be having PE lessons every week and should leave their kits in school. PE kits should be: A school PE t-shirt, blue shorts and pumps (for indoor PE) and a warm blue or black tracksuit and pair of trainers (for outdoor PE). Please ensure all kit is named.

This term Year 1 are looking at poetry, stories by the same author and writing recounts. Please continue to support your child as much as you can with home reading and practising writing and spelling tricky words. The children really enjoy reading a whole range of books as well as our school-reading scheme.

In Science this term, the children will be looking at sound and light.

In their topic work, they will be looking at houses and homes and the historical changes in homes from 100 years ago.
