Homework

The children will have the following work to bring home:- A Home Reading Book and Key Words. They are all doing brilliantly with their reading. The children will also be given a challenge homework book with activities to be completed over the weekend. The children will be having PE lessons every week and should leave their kits in school. PE kits should be: A school PE t-shirt, blue shorts and pumps (for indoor PE) and a warm blue or black tracksuit and pair of trainers (for outdoor PE). Please ensure all kit is named.

This term Reception are looking at poetry and stories with a space theme, as well as learning about letters, captions and labels. The children really enjoy reading a whole range of books as well as our school-reading scheme.

In Maths, Reception are learning about:

- ✓ Multiplication and division
- ✓ Addition and subtraction
- ✓ Length, weight and capacity.

The Reception children will be looking at Minibeast Madness and Pets and Animals. The children have already begun discussing and writing about minibeasts we have seen in the community garden.
