Literacy This term we will be reading stories with familiar settings and creating our own narratives as well as developing our comprehension skills.

Spelling and phonics will be taught on a daily basis and will be linked to handwriting practise.

Maths We are continuing to follow the new Maths Mastery scheme and will look at place value, comparing numbers and finding patterns.

Topic & Science

Our first topic this term is all about castles. We will be learning about different castles, castle life and visiting Skipton Castle.



In **Science** we will be learning about Plants and the conditions they need to grow healthily.
